

Installation Instructions for 717887 CAT-BACK FFX SOS EXHAUST FITS: 2015-2020 FORD F-150 WITH 2.7L / 3.5L / 5.0L ENGINES

OVERVIEW:

 Please take a moment to read and understand these instructions before installing your Flowmaster performance system.

NOTE: Please inventory all parts before starting the installation process and call our tech line to report any missing parts. This will help avoid potentially stranding your vehicle until any missing replacement parts arrive.

REMOVE STOCK EXHAUST SYSTEM:


 Raise vehicle up on a hoist or rack to working height. If you don't have access to a hoist or rack, support vehicle with jack stands.

WARNING:

Avoid serious burns! Allow your vehicle time to cool completely before touching any factory engine components.

To ease disassembly of factory components:

- Apply penetrating lubricant to mounts, bolts and clamps before you remove them.
- Use stands as necessary to support parts as you detach them from your vehicle.

3. Remove bolts (x2) at front flange connection. Cut tailpipe behind muffler, disengage wire hangers from isolators and remove exhaust system from vehicle.



INSTALL FLOWMASTER EXHAUST SYSTEM:

4. Remove nuts from stock and Flowmaster clamps, apply anti-seize compound to bolts and re-install nuts.

NOTE: The image in this step is intended for illustrative purposes only and may or may not accurately reflect components included in your kit.



5. If your vehicle falls within the specifications listed below, apply the corresponding modifications or assembly combinations to this kit to ensure it will install properly.

NOTE: Each slip-fit connection seats 2" deep except for the extension pipe end that seats 3" deep onto the inlet pipe. Mark each slip fit connection accordingly.

 Install inlet pipe (26753M) to catalytic converter (oriented as shown) with (x2 ea.) bolts (HW211) through flat washers (HW303), flange, flat washers (HW303), lock washers (HW309) and nuts (HW103).





NOTE: Complete this step only for applicable builds (reference step 5).

 Place clamp (MC300BS) and front clamp hanger (505HA) onto extension pipe (26277M) then connect it to inlet pipe while sliding wire hanger into isolator. Tighten clamps enough to allow for adjustment.



 Place clamps (x2) (MC300BS) onto each end of FFX muffler (71249-Z) then connect it to extension or inlet pipe. Tighten front clamp enough to allow for adjustment.



9. Route **tailpipe assembly (26754M)** over axle and connect it to muffler outlet. Mount wire hangers into isolators (x2) then tighten clamp enough to allow for adjustment.



- 10. Install **tip (ST509B)** onto tailpipe then tighten inlet.
- 11. Adjust the exhaust components to provide a satisfactory fit. Maintain a minimum of ½" clearance around all components of the exhaust system, keeping in mind suspension, travel and vibration. After making any required adjustments, securely tighten the clamps.
- 12. We recommend applying a one inch tack weld to all slipfit connections for a more secure installation. You may also apply high temperature paint over welded areas to prevent rust and premature corrosion.


