#### STEP 1

Begin by unpacking all items and inspecting for missing pieces or damage. If you have any concerns, please contact the company the product was purchased from.

#### STEP 2

If equipped with factory rock guards or steps, remove them along with all brackets until the pinch weld is clear as shown.








### STEP 3

Using the factory hardware and an 18mm socket, begin by installing the front and rear brackets to the existing front and rear body mounts (Take notice of the orientation in our pictures).

NOTE: Leave these loose so they can be adjusted as needed throughout installation.












## STEP 4

Install bracket onto the rear section of the slider using a 16mm Socket and provided M10 hardware.









#### STEP 5

Install the sliders along the vehicle, using the studs as a guide. All studs should protrude through the holes in the body. NOTE: An extra pair of hands will make this process easier.





### STEP 6

Using a 16mm socket, install two M10x25 bolts and hardware to the front section of the slider, loosely securing it to the front bracket.

NOTE: The slider and bracket may require maneuvering for installation.








#### STEP 7


Using a 16mm socket, install two M10x25 bolts and hardware to the rear of the slider, loosely securing it to the bracket.

NOTE: The slider and bracket may require maneuvering for installation.



#### STEP 8

Install the center factory body bolt into the center body mounts using an 18mm, leaving it loose to allow for adjustment.







## STEP 9

Install the provided M6 hardware to the studs protruding through body on the underside of the vehicle by hand threading them to start. After all nuts have been started on the threads, secure with a 10mm socket.









## STEP 10

Using a 16mm Socket secure the M10x25 bolts loosely holding the sliders to front and rear brackets.









STEP 11

Using an 18mm socket, secure the rear, center, and front factory bolts.










#### **STEP 12**

Install the deflector plate. Using a 16mm socket install the M10x40 bolt, and M10x20 Bolt with hardware in the section connecting with the slider to the body, but do not tighten. The longerM10x40 bolt is being used in the firstpicture, in the lower section of the plate. Using a 13mm socket, install the remaining M8x25

bolt and hardware securing it to the body mount. Secure all bolts on the deflector plate.





STEP 13

Double check all hardware is secure.







## STEP 14

Repeat steps on other side of the vehicle.
