


I. Overview

- White Lithium Grease



V. Installation Instructions

A. Mount the Latch Hook Bracket to the driver side of the bumper using five of the included 7/16" bolts and washers.




Figure 1 – Latch Hook Bracket Installation

B. With Latch hook bracket installed, use two stainless steel countersunk socket head cap screws to attach the tire carrier landing pad to the latch hook bracket. Use a washer, lock washer, and nut on the back side of each bolt to secure the landing pad.



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


Figure 2 – Tire carrier landing pad installation

C. Mount the Lower Pivot Mount bracket to the passenger side of the bumper using three of the included 7/16" bolts and washers.




Figure 3 – Lower Pivot Mount bracket installation



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D. Insert the Tire Carrier Pivot Shaft into the cup in the lower pivot mount bracket. Thread one of the included 3/8"-24 bolts in from the bottom and tighten.




Figure 4 – Pivot Shaft Installation

E. Install the black plastic T-Handle plunger into the Barrel Housing welded to the Tire Carrier Pivot Housing.




Figure 5 – T-Handle plunger installation



F. Apply a thin coat of white lithium grease to the perforated side of the included flat thrust washers and the inside of the bearings that are installed from Fab Fours into the Pivot Housing. A coat thick enough to fill the holes will suffice. Please contact Fab Fours immediately if the cylindrical bearings are not installed in the tire carrier pivot housing.

G. Install one of the thrust washers onto the shaft with the greased perforated side facing down onto the lower pivot mount bracket's top face. Then slide the tire carrier assembly gently onto the shaft being careful not to damage the bearings greased in the previous step. Then place the remaining thrust washer on the top of the pivot housing with the greased perforated side facing up.




Figure 6 – Thrust washer installation



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H. Install the upper pivot mount bracket onto the bumper using five of the provided 7/16" bolts and washers, and the remaining 3/8"-24 bolt in the top of the pivot shaft.




Figure 7 – Upper pivot mount bracket installation

I. Using the supplied hardware, attach the Latch Hook and Lanyard tab to the Latch Handle. Make sure the opposite end of the Lanyard is through the retaining pin (not s hown). The latch hook uses the 1/4"-20 screw and Nylok nut to attach to the tire carrier, and the lanyard tab uses the #10 screw and Nylok nut to fasten to the latch handle.




Figure 8 – Latch Hook installation



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


Figure 9 – Latch Hook Installation

J. Install the two stop pads on the tire carrier bracket using the four included, stainless steel countersunk socket head cap screws, 3/8" washers, lock washers, and hex nuts.




Figure 10 – Tire carrier stop pad installation



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K. Insert the supplied grease fitting into the back side of the tire carrier pivot housing as shown.




Figure 11 – Installation of grease fitting into pivot housing

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L. Use the supplied 7/16"-14 x1.25" long bolts, washers (each side), lock washers, and nuts to secure the tire carrier horizontal mount to the tire carrier with 4 bolts passing through each side and the nuts located on the inside of the channel of the tire carrier.

M. Install one 7/16-14x1" long bolt, 2 washers, lock washer, and nut through the hole passing through the top section of both locating the nut again on the inside of the channel.

N. Retighten all bolts in the assembly!

O. With the tire carrier latched shut, place the spare tire onto the tire carrier and use M12x 1.5 lug nuts to secure it to the OEM specifications in your owner's manual.

P. If you own or plan to purchase a CB Radio, your Fab Fours Tire Carrier comes standard with a CB Antenna mount shown below.




Figure 15 – CB Radio antenna mount



VI. Tire Carrier Operation

A. To open the latch mechanism, remove spring lock pin, firmly grasp handle, and rotate as shown below to release compression on the latch bumper. ALWAYS USE THE SPRING PIN WHEN LATCH IS IN THE CLOSED POSITION!



B. Your tire carrier is equipped with a retaining pin that will hold your tire carrier open when getting items in and out of the back of the vehicle. It, however, is not to be used as a catch for swinging the tire carrier opened uncontrolled for it to engage. Any un-controlled opening could result in damage to the tire carrier itself, the bumper, and possibly the vehicle it is installed on. PLEASE USE CAUTION WHEN OPENING!



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C. Once Tire Carrier is opened and the retaining pin pops into place, you must pull the T-Handle (Highlighted Below) downward while pulling the Tire Carrier closed.




Figure 16 – Retaining pin operation



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VII. Maintenance/Care

- □ Periodically check and tighten all fasteners
- □ Stripped, fractured, or bent bolts or nuts need to be replaced
- Periodically grease the tire carrier pivot
- Periodically check the tension of the latch hook
